### **Dave Murray National Masters Cup**

The Dave Murray National Masters Cup was donated by Alpine Canada to promote top participation and performance at the Canadian Masters Alpine Championships.

#### **Eligible Competitors**

Must be on the National Points List and race for the province in which they were registered.

#### **Regional Teams**

- West—BC
- Central—Alberta and Prairies
- East—Ontario, Quebec, and Atlantic

#### **Scoring Method**

Finishers in each age group will receive points for their team i.e. 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 9 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc. There are 26 age groups (13M/13F). Each team may only score one female and one male per age group up to a maximum of 20 racers—the ultimate score is 200 points per event.

Points from all 3 or 4 races will be tallied and the team with the highest cumulative score will win.

#### **Tiebreaker**

The regional team with the best score in the last race event will be declared the overall winner.

#### **Trophy Winners**

The trophy was originally awarded to the top province. Two regional teams (east & west) were formed in 2006. The current three regions were defined in 2009 in an effort to find a fair regional balance, the results of which demonstrate this.
