

# **Reciprocation Policy**

### Purpose

1. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure national enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by Alpine Canada Alpin ("ACA"), Members, and Clubs.

### Application

2. This Policy applies to ACA, all Members and Clubs.

### Responsibilities

- 3. ACA will:
  - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions (including any sanctions imposed by the CSSP) to all Members and to the Club(s) affected or impacted by a decision.
  - b) For discipline decisions provided to ACA by a Member or by a Club, determine per the <u>Discipline and Complaints Policy</u> whether to initiate further action against the Registered Participant(s) named in the decision.
  - c) Comply with any publication requirements established by the CSSP regarding sanctions imposed on CSSP Participants.
  - d) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by a Member and/or a Club.
- 4. Members will:
  - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Registered Participants to ACA and to the Club(s) affected or impacted by a decision.
  - b) For discipline decisions provided to a Member by ACA or by a Club, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Registered Participant(s) named in the decision.
  - c) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by ACA and/or a Club.
  - d) Update their governing documents as necessary to reference the required reciprocation procedures.
- 5. Clubs will:
  - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Registered Participants to ACA and to the Member with which the Club is affiliated.
  - b) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by ACA and/or a Member.

- c) Update their governing documents as necessary to reference the required reciprocation procedures.
- 6. Canadian Safe Sport Program (CSSP):
  - a) ACA, Members and Clubs will recognize and enforce any CSSP sanctions imposed on CSSP Participants of ACA.
