



## 2019 WINTER UNIVERSIADE SELECTION CRITERIA

Updated June 2018

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

Selection to participate in the 2019 Krasnoyarsk Winter Universiade competition March 2-12, 2019, is eligible to the following individuals:

- a) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of Canada
- b) Former student of the institution mentioned in (a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event
- c) Be a citizen of Canada and hold a CAN international FIS license for the 2018-2019 season
- d) Be at least 17 and less than 25 years of age (born between January 1 1994 and December 31, 2001)
- e) Be a member in good standing with Alpine Canada Alpin (ACA) and the athlete's member province

### 2. QUOTA

Canada is allocated 6 quota spots per gender for the alpine disciplines with 4 quota spots for ski cross. The selection committee reserves the right not to fulfill the allocated quota if not enough athletes are qualified for the Universiade level of competition.

The selection committee also reserves the right to name more than the allocated quota for the alpine event, where athletes would only participate in select events where their potential to perform is identified.

Finally, the selection committee reserves the right to name up to two, 'wildcard' alpine athletes that may have been injured in the qualification period.

### 3. CRITERIA

*All interested athletes will be reviewed on the following criteria.*

*Alpine:*

- Athletes will be selected in accordance to their world rank in GS plus next best discipline based on results according to the base FIS points list published June, 2018
- Athletes will be selected in accordance to their past experience in speed events
- Athletes will be selected in such a fashion to ensure that at least 50% of the chosen male and female athletes are attending Canadian Interuniversity Sport Member Institutes



### *Ski Cross:*

- Athletes will be selected according to the base list published June 2018.

\*\*\* Pending the interest from ski cross athletes, the selection committee reserves the right to potentially open ski cross entry to identified alpine athletes interested in competing in ski cross. A FIS freestyle competitor card must be held in order for an athlete to participate in a ski cross event.

## **4. APPLICATION**

Athletes wishing to be considered for selection to Team Canada are required to submit all application requirements outlined below to the Senior Manager, Domestic Sport Services at [aavoledo@alpinecanada.org](mailto:aavoledo@alpinecanada.org) by **September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018**.

Any application submitted that are not completed in full will not be accepted.

## **5. COACH ELIGIBILITY**

All coaches wishing to be considered for Team Canada must meet minimum USport and ACA standards.

Exemptions from the outlined standards are only possible in exceptional cases as determined by USport and ACA on case by case basis.

Minimum standard:

- Member in good standing with CSC prior to December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018
- CSC DL Certified
- NCCP Comp – Dev status or Level 3 certification
