Purpose

1. The purpose of this Policy is to ensure national enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by Alpine Canada Alpin (“ACA”), Members, and Clubs.

Application

2. This Policy applies to ACA, all Members and Clubs.

Responsibilities

3. ACA will:
 - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions (including any sanctions imposed by the OSIC) to all Members and to the Club(s) affected or impacted by a decision.
 - b) For discipline decisions provided to ACA by a Member or by a Club, determine per the [Discipline and Complaints Policy](#) whether to initiate further action against the Registered Participant(s) named in the decision.
 - c) Comply with any publication requirements established by the OSIC regarding sanctions imposed on Abuse Free Sport Participants.
 - d) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by a Member and/or a Club.
4. Members will:
 - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Registered Participants to ACA and to the Club(s) affected or impacted by a decision.
 - b) For discipline decisions provided to a Member by ACA or by a Club, determine per its own policies whether to initiate further action against the Registered Participant(s) named in the decision.
 - c) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by ACA and/or a Club.
 - d) Update their governing documents as necessary to reference the required reciprocity procedures.
5. Clubs will:
 - a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal decisions involving Registered Participants to ACA and to the Member with which the Club is affiliated.
 - b) Recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by ACA and/or a Member.

- c) Update their governing documents as necessary to reference the required reciprocity procedures.
