Overview:

An Adaptive Snowsports Instructor will assist RMA in their delivery of their adaptive winter programs by teaching and assisting in adaptive ski or snowboard lessons at Sunshine Village and other resorts.

Duties:

The RMA Adaptive Snowsports instructor performs a wide range of duties including some or all of the following:

- Teach a variety of adaptive ski or snowboard lessons
- Liaise with RMA guests and their families
- Keep weekly reports of lessons
- Assist with raising awareness of RMA and fundraising events
- Perform other such duties as may be assigned

Working Conditions

- Part-time position, 1 or 2 days per week
- Frequently required to work outdoors in Winter conditions
- Will receive regular training in adaptive ski and ride instruction

- Advanced skiing or riding abilities
- Strong ability to adapt teaching methods
- CSIA or CASI certifications or international equivalent (Minimum Level 1), Adaptive skiers and Riders can apply with CADS certification or international equivalent.
- CADS certifications or international equivalent an asset
- Mandatory background check
