CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position will be a seasonal full time position for a duration of 7 to 10 months. Experience and qualifications will be considered in compensation & contract terms.

The main goal for this position is to relieve the head coach and assistant coach of certain duties, to allow them to work directly with the athletes on a daily basis (on & off snow).

Primary responsibilities would include:

- Assistance in set up of DTE
- On hill duties including, but not limited to setting up and monitoring timing system, shooting video & course maintenance
- Athlete management off-snow including, but not limited to running off-snow dryland, organizing team events and assisting with video capture and review
- Assisting in ski preparation at training and competition venues, as requested by ski service lead
- Ensuring the safety and wellbeing of athletes during training camps and events
- Tracking, monitoring and reporting of camps and races
- Tracking, monitoring and reporting on identified athletes
- Timely expense reporting

- 5+ years of coaching experience at a FIS level (alpine or ski cross)
- World Cup Ski Cross coach experience considered an asset
- Proven track record of coaching in programs with strong athletic performances
- Excellent grasp of video analysis software and experience operating timing systems
