NAC FOREIGN QUOTA:	If a National Ski Association wishes to expand their NAC quota to the FIS level, a letter from the NSA must be submitted to ACA raceentries@alpinecanada.org , at least 10 days prior to the first TC' meeting (MARCH 21, 2024) in order to be considered. Approval will be subject to entry levels (NAC 2.3.3) and may not be determined until the TC' meeting.		
LIFT TICKETS:	Lift tickets (\$58.43 CAD per day) will be available for purchase through the online payment processors. Refer to NAC 2.4.2 for qualification of complimentary lift tickets. NAC lift tickets are valid for race days only. (April 7th – NO PASSES) CanWest Passes are accepted, to be collected at Guest Services.
