Canadian Masters' Alpine Team

Eligibility

- Male and female athletes aged 18 and older as of December 31, 2012.
- Registered as a National or FIS Competitor on Alpine Canada National Points List (NPL) prior to the Masters National Championships at Nakiska.
- Must be a Canadian citizen or have Canadian resident status.

Qualification - Participation Criteria

- Minimum of 5 starts in any Masters Races as scheduled on the 2012-2013 Masters National Events Calendar.
- Minimum of 2 starts must occur at any one of the events listed on the calendar outside one's home region. Home Region is defined as per a racer's competitor card registration.
- The Calendar includes races in 6 Home Regions in Canada, split into two divisions:
 - o West: BC West [Whistler], BC Interior [Silver Star], and Alberta
 - o East: Ontario, Quebec, and the Maritimes

Selection - Performance Criteria

- Two racers who meet the participation criteria will be selected from each female and male age group; 18-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85 +. One female racer and one male racer will be selected from the Western Division and one female and one male racer will be selected from the Eastern Division. In the event of a tie, then all tying racers will be selected. The division between West and East is the border between Manitoba and Ontario.
- The CMAT winners for each age group, male and female, in either the Western or Eastern Divisions will be selected according to the highest World Cup points total based on the following criteria: The winner[s] will be determined by the total score of the racers' best 5 results for Western racers or, best 7 results for Eastern racers as per the Participation Criteria. If a racer participates in fewer starts, then the total of a racer's actual starts will be used.
- Racers may collect points in any Region in any National Masters Race; all points collected will count towards a racer's point total in their home division (east or west).
- World Cup Points 1st-100 points, 2nd-80, 3d-60, 4th-50, 5th-45, 6th-40, 7th-36, etc.

Selection Process

The Committee will issue a CMAT Nominations Preview based on the mid-April World Cup Points lists. Qualified competitors will be listed by gender, by age group and ranked by points as outlined in Performance Criteria. Selection Committee members will validate the list and qualifying competitors will be named to the CMAT.
