#### The Position:

Alpine Canada Alpine (ACA) is the national governing body for Ski Racing in Canada and home to three of Canada's most exciting snow sports: Alpine, Para-Alpine and Ski Cross Racing. The organization has a strong Board and senior management leadership that are committed to a vision for Canada to be a World Class ski racing nation inspired by the passion and performance of Canada's ski teams. Our mission is to increase Canadian Ski Racing podium performances AND inspire growth in participation and fans.

We are currently seeking an experienced and dynamic individual to join our organization in the role of World Cup Coach, CPAST.

Reporting to the Head Coach, CPAST, the World Cup Coach is a member of the Canadian Para-Alpine World Cup Team. This role will support ACA's mission to increase podium performance by providing technical leadership and coaching to the World Cup Team. The successful candidate will have extensive coaching and technical qualifications, strong communication skills and effective organizational skills.

### **Duties:**

- Work in conjunction with all team coaches to design, implement, and monitor annual training and competition plan
- Assist in record-keeping of all collected data
- Monitor Athlete's equipment needs and liaise proactively with the equipment representatives
- Provide assistance and oversee maintenance and control of team equipment
- Provide timely and effective communication to Athletes, Coaches, and Alpine Canada Alpin
- Provide assistance in all on-snow duties (ie. course preparation, course-setting, and course maintenance
- Ensure welfare and health of Athletes when travelling
- Ability to monitor dryland program and/or assist in ski preparations an asset
- Timely expense reporting
- Manage key logistics as determined by Head Coach

# **Working Conditions**

- Full-time
- Constant travel is to be expected especially between August and May to attend training camps and competitions
- There will be periods of significant overtime. Time off in lieu is provided where scheduling permits
- Work is frequently outdoors in winter conditions

- 5+ Years in leadership role within FIS, NorAm, WPAS World Cup or higher-level experience
- Advanced skiing abilities.
- Strong leadership skills.
- Certification in ACA-CSC or International equivalent.
- German and/or French fluency an asset.
