### Race Point Manipulation

### POLICY

Adopted by ACA National Officials Committee – 2009

---

*Any Canadian competitor, official or coach clearly involved in artificially affecting the calculation of penalty or points, encouraging or instructing competitors to finish in a manner that will affect the results, may, on recommendation of the Technical Delegate and/or Jury be recommended for sanction which can include DSQ, removal from results and further penalties, including suspension and non-scoring of the race.*

*All such recommendations for sanctions will be reviewed by a special disciplinary hearing chaired by appointee's from the CSA, ACA and ACA National Officials Committee.*

The policy was adopted by the ACA National Officials Committee and the ACA TD Working Group in September 2009 after 2 years of discussion and supported by the Canadian Snowsports Association (CSA). It follows closely a similar policy enacted by USSA.
