Race Point Manipulation POLICY

Adopted by ACA National Officials Committee - 2009

Any Canadian competitor, official or coach clearly involved in artificially affecting the calculation of penalty or points, encouraging or instructing competitors to finish in a manner that will affect the results, may, on recommendation of the Technical Delegate and/or Jury be recommended for sanction which can include DSQ, removal from results and further penalties, including suspension and non-scoring of the race.

All such recommendations for sanctions will be reviewed by a special disciplinary hearing chaired by appointee's from the CSA, ACA and ACA National Officials Committee.

The policy was adopted by the ACA National Officials Committee and the ACA TD Working Group in September 2009 after 2 years of discussion and supported by the Canadian Snowsports Association (CSA). It follows closely a similar policy enacted by USSA.
